Ensure the space is safe, organized, and welcoming before and after each event. • <u>Event Logistics Coordination</u>: Work alongside the Event Manager to help coordinate and implement event logistics, ensuring instructions are followed and key details are carried out smoothly. • <u>On-Site Problem Solving & Support</u>: Support the team in responding to and resolving any unexpected logistical or operational challenges during the event to maintain a smooth flow. • <u>Guest Welcome & Check-In</u>: Greet participants upon arrival, assist with ticket scanning or registration, and respond to general questions to create a welcoming and informed experience. • <u>Active Participation in Event</u>: Take part in the drum circle experience, helping to contribute to an inclusive, grounded, and engaging group environment. • <u>Community Engagement & Promotion (Optional)</u>: Share and promote events and the organization's mission through personal or community social media channels, where appropriate.
